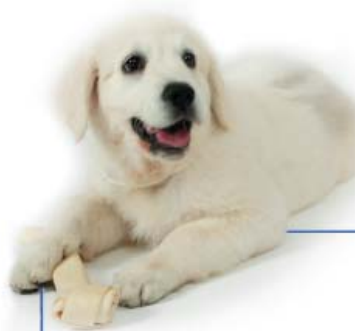

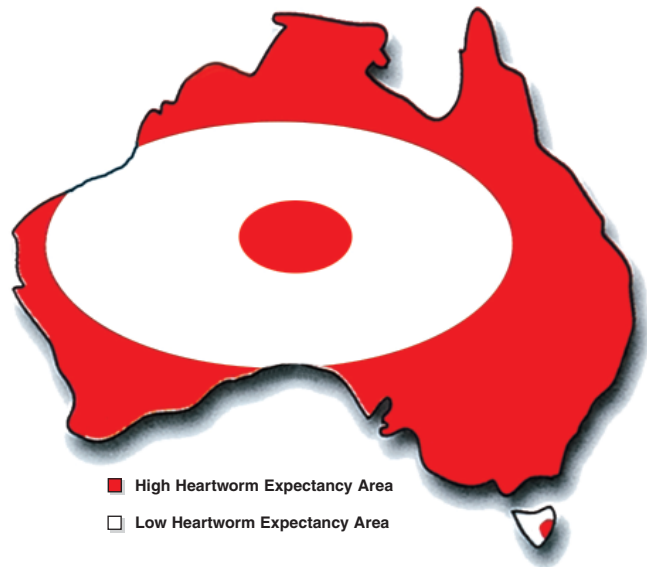

What is Heartworm Disease?

Heartworm (*Dirofilaria immitis*) disease is spread by mosquitoes and has the potential to cause heart failure and death. Your pet does not have to be in contact with other dogs to develop this disease. **More than 65% of the dog population in Australia lives in high heartworm expectancy areas.**



Heartworm disease is spread by mosquitoes.

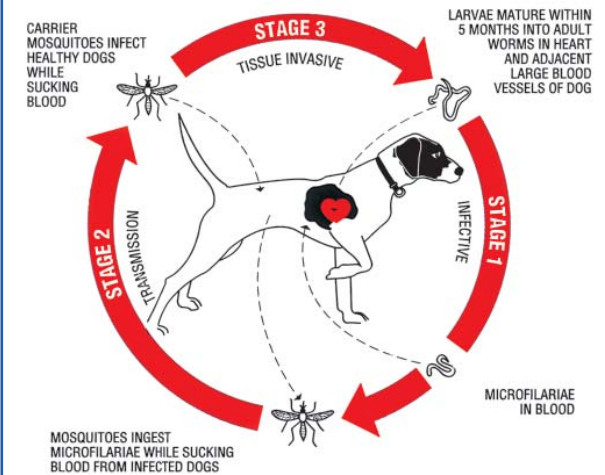


Once-A-Year Heartworm Prevention uses sustained-release technology to protect your dog for a full 12 month period.

Once-A-Year Heartworm Prevention is administered by your vet and takes away the risk of forgetting monthly or daily dosing. Simply arrange to treat your dog as a part of the annual health check, and you can forget about heartworm ... for a whole year!

The Heartworm Lifecycle



It may only take a single bite from a carrier mosquito to infect your dog. The parasite larvae move through the tissues beneath the skin. These larvae then migrate to the heart and adjacent blood vessels of the lungs where they grow into adult worms.

In the early stages of heartworm infection, there may be no outward signs of disease. Your vet may recommend a simple blood test before starting heartworm prevention for the first time, or if a dose has been missed.
